Dear God, when we face life's problems, help us to be willing to follow the directions You've given us in the Bible. In Jesus' name, **amen**.

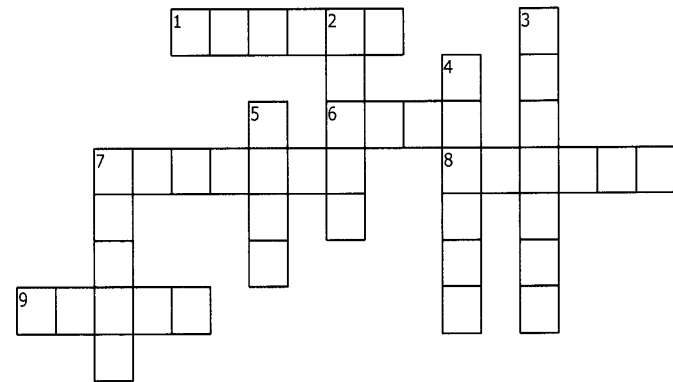

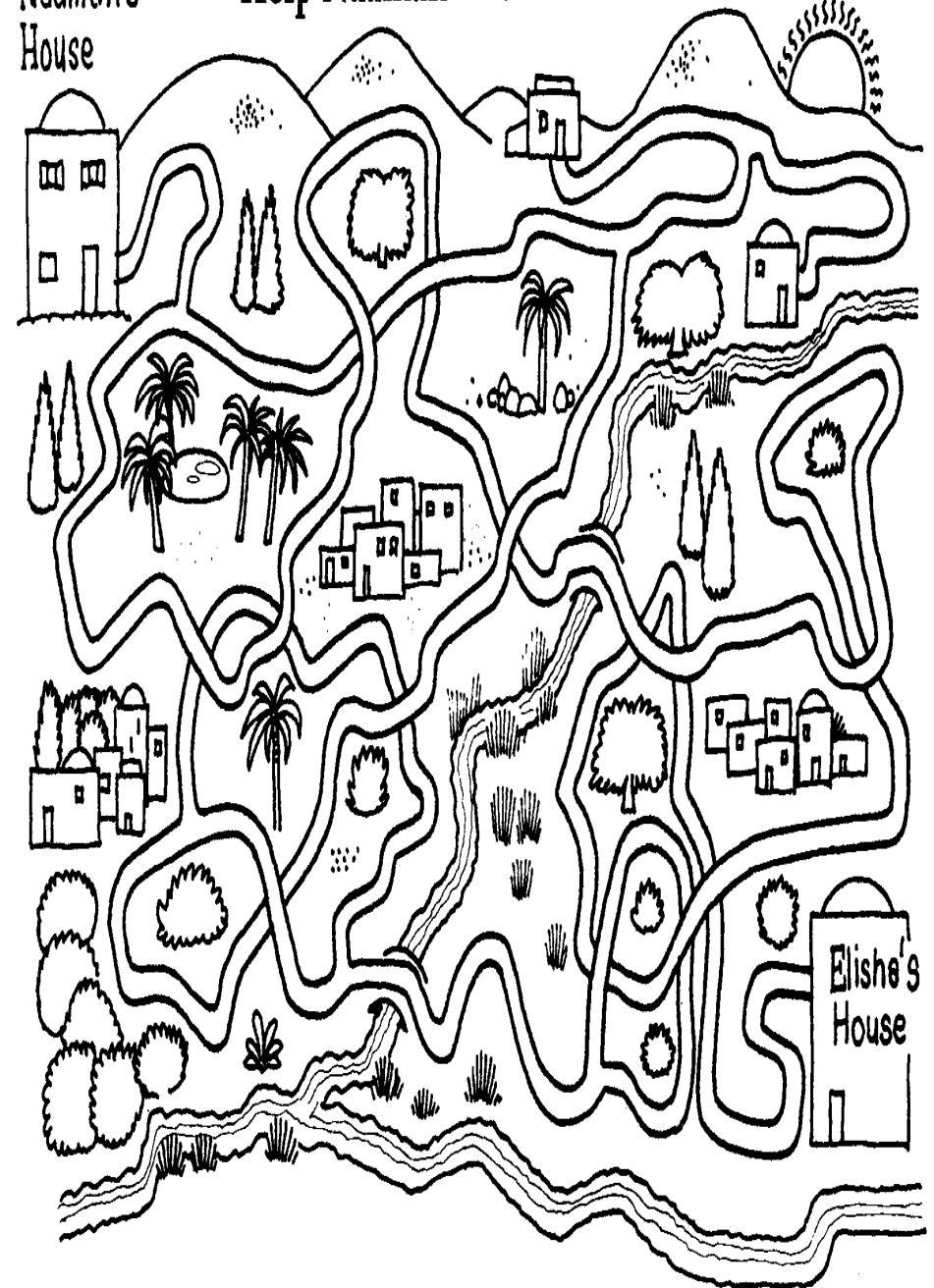


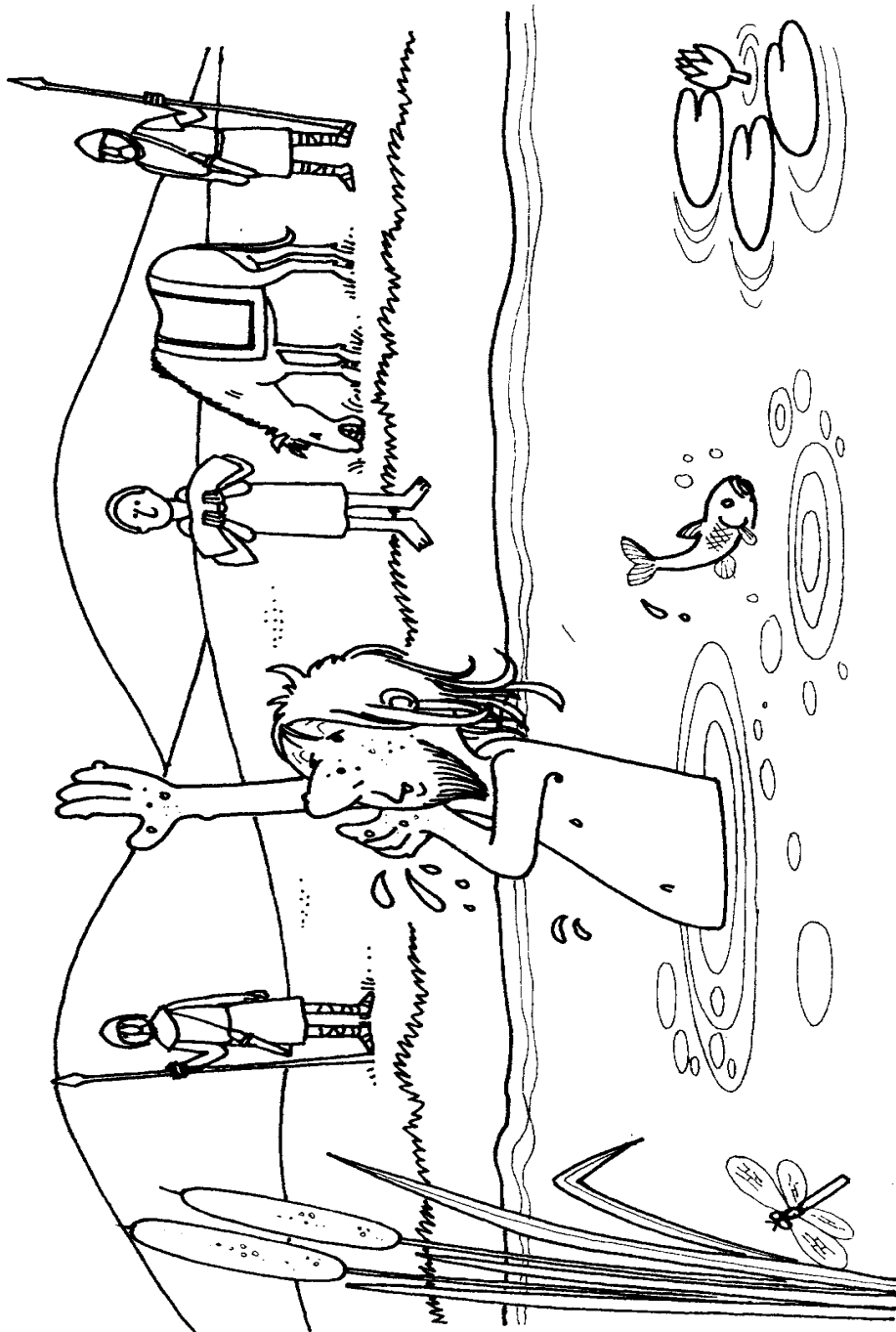
