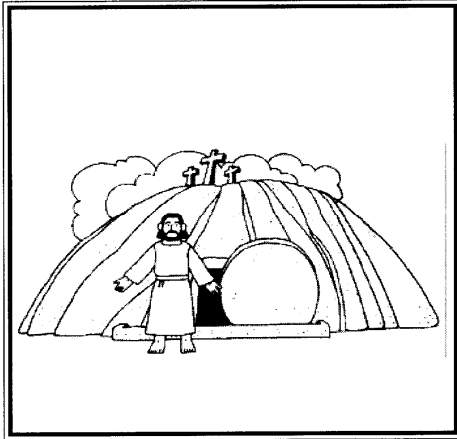
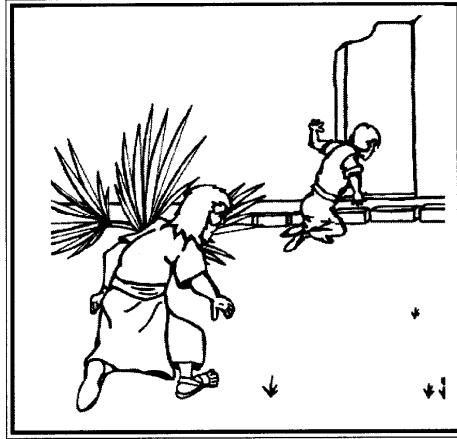


# Do you know about Easter?

Ask your parents to help tell the story to you this week.



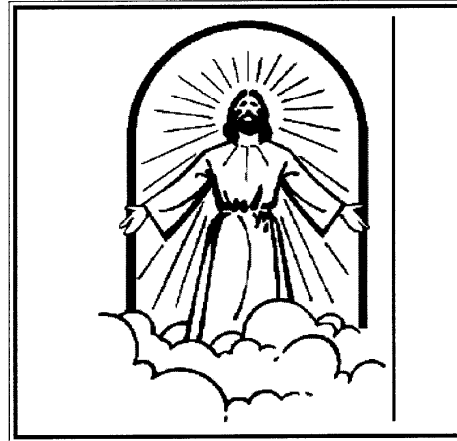
Jesus rose after he died on the cross

Heavenly Father, the empty tomb is no mystery to us. He is risen! We rejoice in his name. Amen.



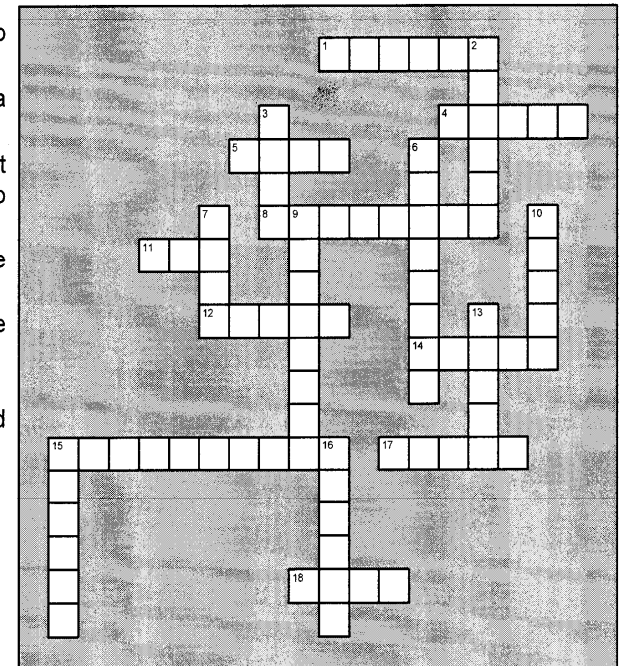
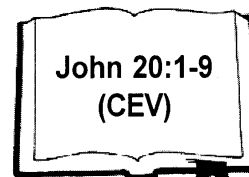
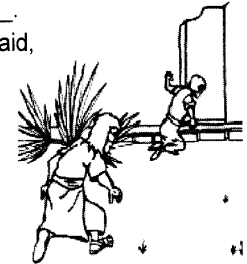

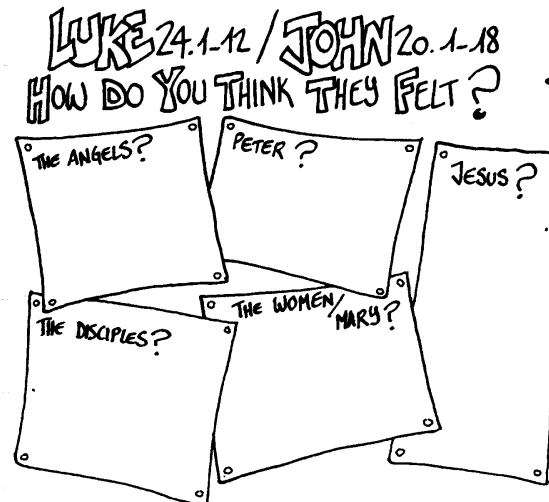


**THE EMPTY TOMB?**

 He would have been in a very weak state if this was true, and he wasn't. Also, they had pierced him so he would have bled to death if he hadn't already been dead.

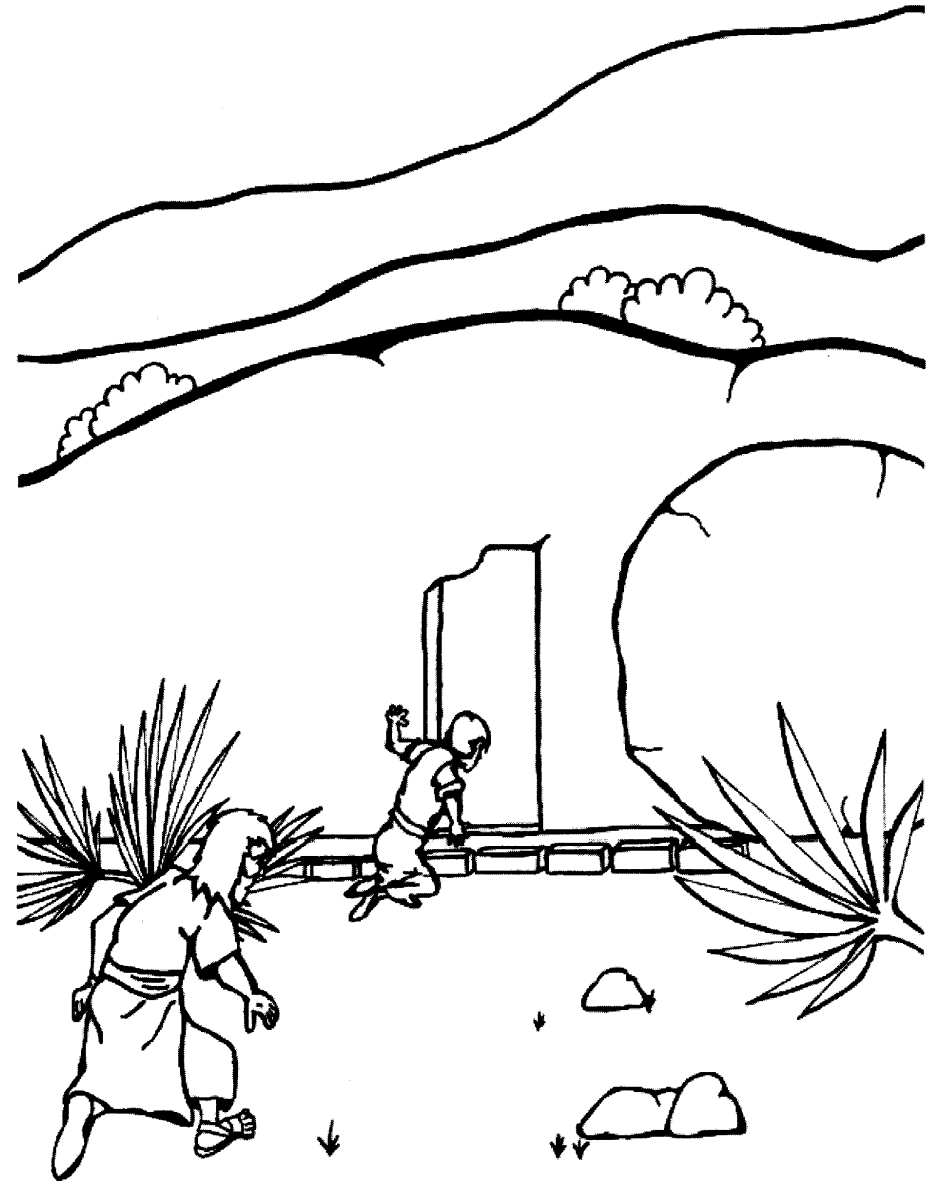
**COULD HIS FOLLOWERS HAVE STOLEN HIS BODY?**

**BUT PEOPLE DON'T COME BACK TO LIFE!** Exactly. We are bound to consider the possibility of Jesus really being the Son of God.



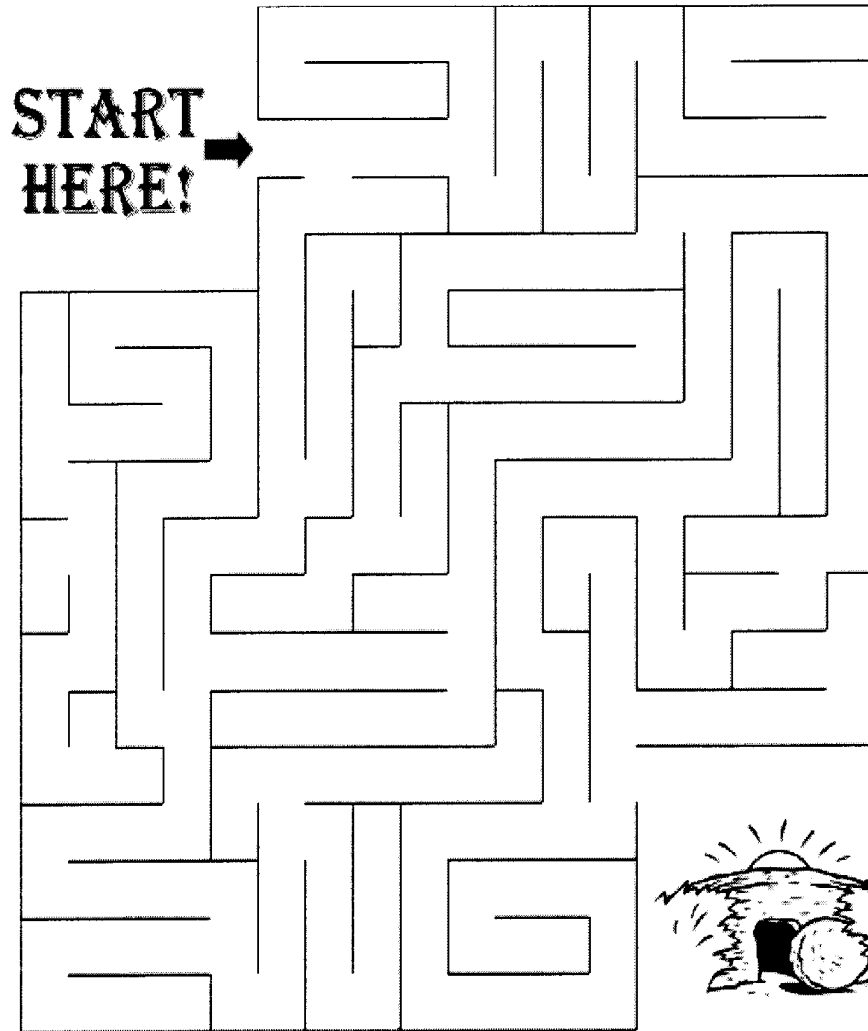
