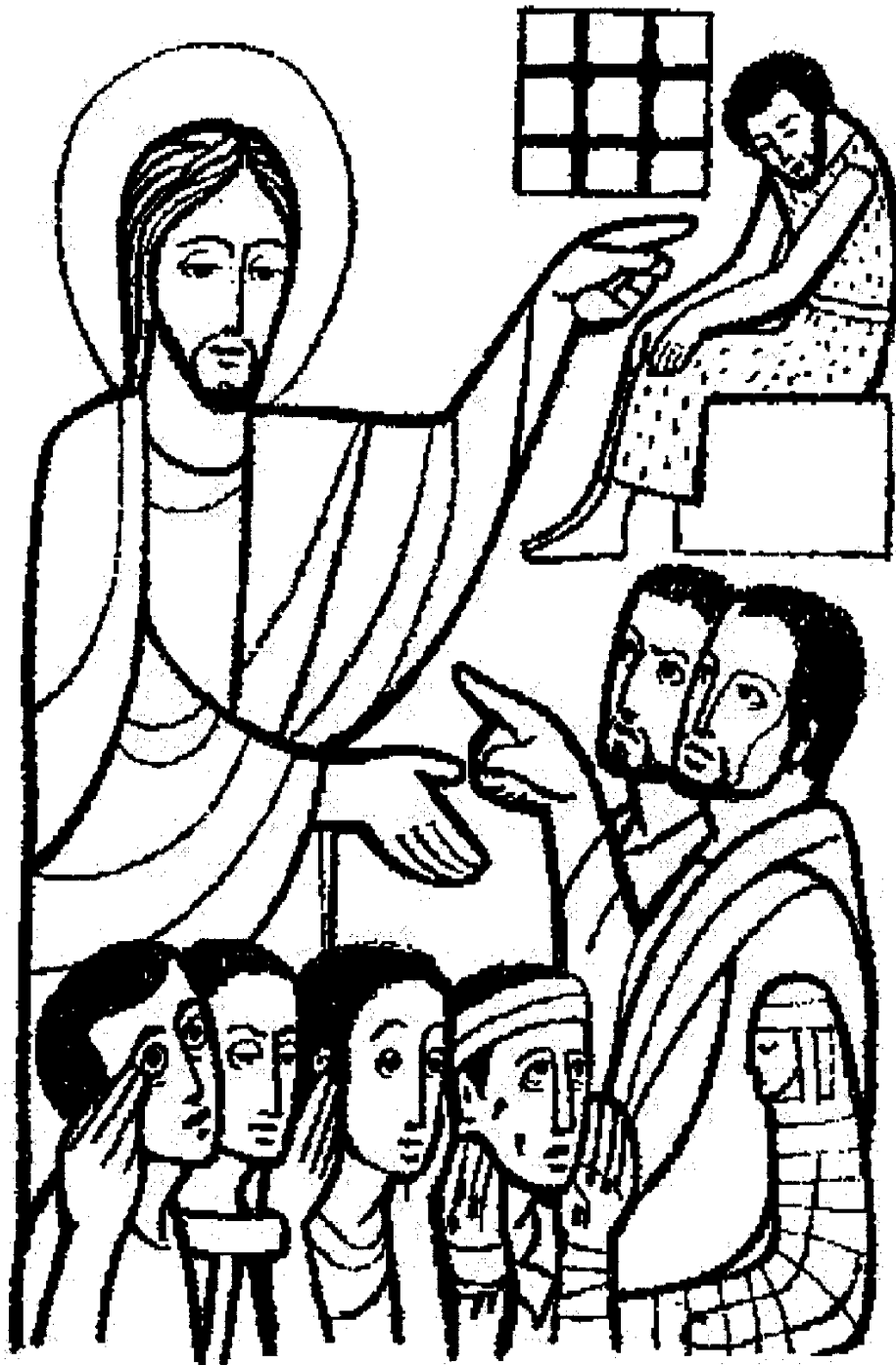

WHAT DOES 'MESSIAH' MEAN?

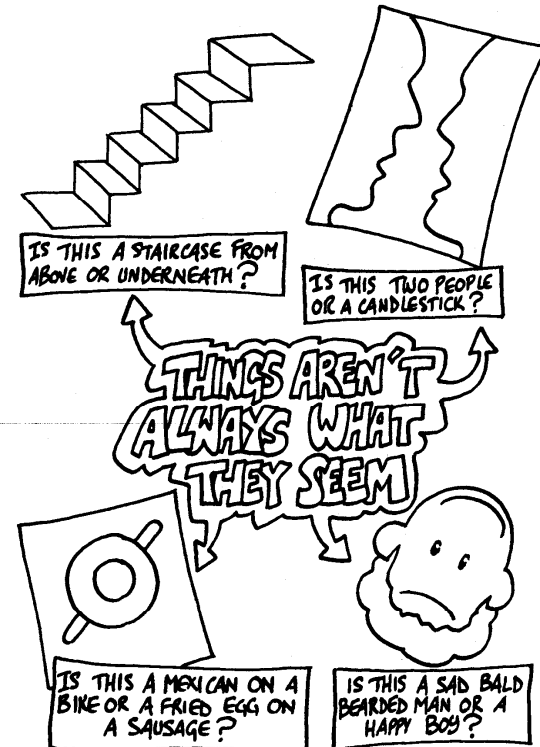
'Messiah' or 'Christ' was the one God would send to save his people. The Jewish people were waiting for him to come.
