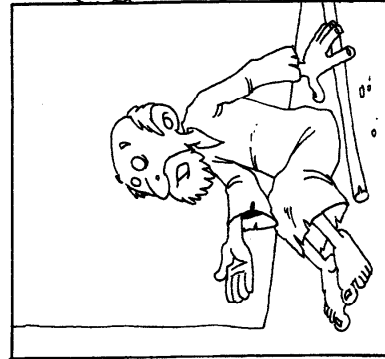

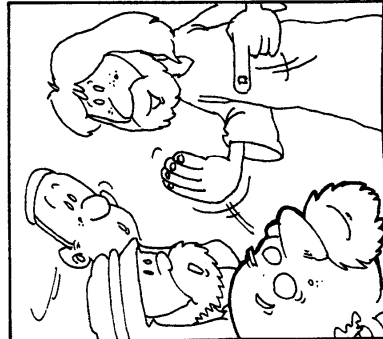

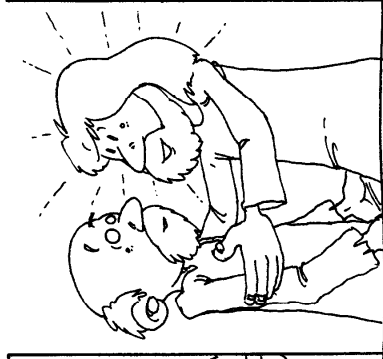

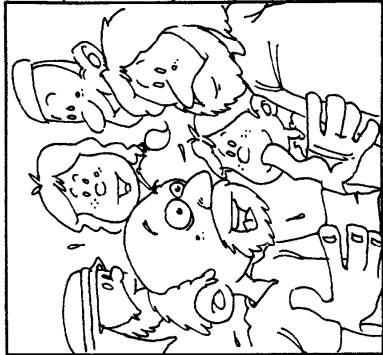
Mark 10:46-52. How are people who can see, sometimes blind



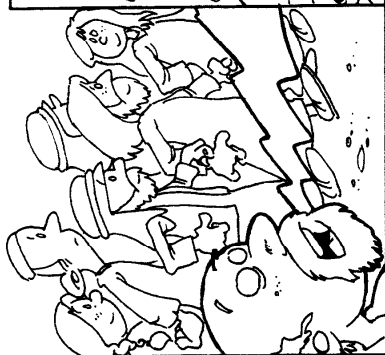
How often does Jesus hear us when we pray?



Who do you know who needs Jesus' healing?



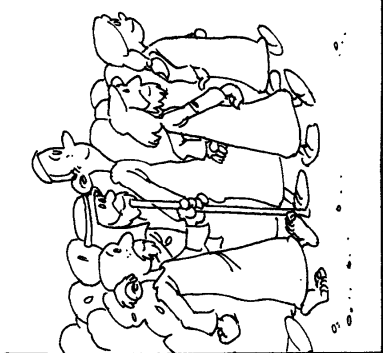
What do you want to thank Jesus for?

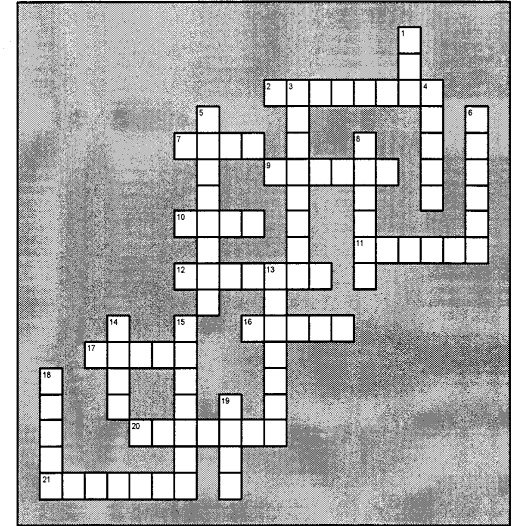
